SAFE: Facilitator Training

Learn how to run 'Keeping Children Safe', a six session community group program based on a psycho-educational model which aims to assist parents/carers to have a greater awareness of child abuse and neglect and its effects. It also assists them to develop a variety of tools and skills to help protect children and become more committed to creating a safe environment for children and young people. The target group for the program includes any person in the community who cares for or is in contact with children.

What to expect from the training:

- Discuss the effects of the program on parents
- Discover the variety of ways that the program can be utilized with individuals and develop the essential skills and knowledge to facilitate the program
- Work through and present sections of the manual
- Receive a facilitator's manual

- Workers who want to expand their group programs
- Workers who want a tool to talk with parents about child abuse and neglect
- Workers who want to develop and expand their group work skills
