

# MOTIVATING FAMILIES

Frontline workers confront increasingly complex situations where family dynamics and the home environment are affected by factors both internal and external to the family. One of the many challenges for workers is to have on hand many different approaches when having conversations with families and when facing resistance or the feeling that nothing is changing.

The workshop aims to provide an opportunity for participants to expand their skills in working with families, develop skills in motivating families, explore tools and a variety of methods of 'questioning', develop their knowledge and practical repertoire.

## Participants will explore:

- The diversity of issues presented when working with a family
- Increase their knowledge of a variety of strategies to use when faced with the variety of issues within family work
- Ways to empower/motivate families to identify the need to change and support them to make the change
- A wide variety of tools and activities to help families develop strategies that will make a difference in their life
