

# Suicide Assessment, Intervention & Post Trauma Support

## Course Description

This course will equip you with both skills and knowledge for working directly with people who are suicidal, as well as family, friends and significant others who are affected by an attempted or completed suicide. The program will focus on assessment of level of suicidality, safety planning and post intervention.

- The myths and facts about suicide
- How to recognize warning signs
- How to identify level of risk
- The principles of crisis intervention
- How to make an appropriate referral
- How to respond to suicide survivors

This course is for people working in the health or welfare sector looking to develop their skills in this area within a systemic counselling context. It would benefit participants to have a knowledge of systems theory and practice.
